


REPORT ON

Speaking on this occasion regarding the deaf culture and inclusion of person with deafness at cross cultural level which is the ultimate inclusion where person with deafness are completely assimilated into the society. We discussed various needs, aspirations of person with deafness and expectations from the hearing world for their inclusion. He informed the august gathering that the deaf persons do not like branding of "Hearing Impaired", "Hearing Handicapped" , "Differently abled" etc which looks soft to the hearing persons but act more of cosmetic rather than real help. Further, these concepts give scope for partially deaf person or hearing person to get fake handicap certificate which eventually harm the prospectus of deaf persons. Therefore he appealed to be called as deaf persons

rather than calling any cosmetic terminology. He appealed the hearing world to give chance and facilitate them to be included rather than being contradictory and counter productive . On this August occasion the Chief Guest distributed Laptops to SC/ST students . Dr.Gouri Shanker Patil gave vote of thanks. Cultural Programme followed.
